

PYRAMID ACCREDITATION DOCUMENT

APPENDIX 1

Aspiring Feeder League Clubs

For 2017 season and beyond, the Birmingham and District Premier Cricket League has increased requirements for accreditation in the Premier League structure. Some of these requirements have been incorporated into the latest Pyramid Accreditation document such as the need for 10 pitches on the square (previously 8) but many are thought to be beyond the requirements of the majority of Feeder League clubs. Clubs who aspire to BDPCL status should be aware that they will need to satisfy extra criteria in order to be accepted. They should consult the latest BDPCL Accreditation document for full details. The main differences are:

5	Pitches	Minimum of 10 pitches on main square - 5 must have 45 yard boundary
9	Roll-on covers	BDPCL aiming at roll-on covers for all clubs (Prem and Div 1 Mandatory now. Div 2 and 3 by 2019)
10,11	Sheets	Side sheets and Bowlers run up sheets – Mandatory
13	Water hog	Mandatory
20	Sightscreens	2 screens at each end – Mandatory
21	Scorebox	BDPCL uses laptop scoring and live on “Total Cricket Scorer” on line. Requires power for 2 laptops and a printer for DLS target grids. Wi-Fi in the scorebox desirable. Board requires last man’s score and DLS Target score which should be updated every over.
26	Bell	Mandatory
27	Changing Room	Sufficient seating for 12 players
34	Bar	Mandatory open during the match
39	Youth Cricket	Must have teams playing in County competitions at 3 levels – U11, U13 and U15.

Additional

Adequate external seating for players and spectators
Adequate Car Parking for players, officials and spectators.
